



INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. You should have on your desk a piece of note paper and this instruction sheet. **Both of these are not to be taken away.**
2. Place your student identity card and enrolment record sheet on the right-hand side of your desk.
3. You will need a pen or pencil to make notes with. All your other belongings should be put in your bag or on the table in the centre (or at the back / front) of the room.
4. If you have a mobile phone or other electronic device, please turn it off now and put it in your bag or on the table in the centre (or at the back / front) of the room. Only switching to vibration/silent mode is not acceptable.
5. If you have a bag, zip it up and put it on the table in the centre (or at the back / front) of the room. Do not leave your bag or books on the floor.
6. The DELTA consists of four tests: listening, vocabulary, reading and grammar. You will first do the listening test and then you will have the remaining time to complete the other three tests.
7. The listening, reading and grammar tests consist of two or more parts. You can navigate between the different parts of each test and between tests by using the tabs at the top of the screen. **Please note that you cannot view the vocabulary, reading and grammar tests until after the listening test has finished.**
8. During the whole session, if you have any requests or questions or if you are in need of assistance of any kind, please do not hesitate to put up your hand. We'll do our best to help.
9. Please remain seated and wait for the invigilator's further instructions. You are not allowed to use the computer until you are instructed to do so.
